Although she can only stand for 20-30 seconds, long enough to get a treat or two or a drink of water...a miracle is in the works. Her nerves are regenerating! Two years ago, with a severed spinal cord, her family was encouraged to euthanize her. Instead, they opted for back surgery and physical therapy.

With your help, we have continued that--when a dog who had been paralyzed in her hind area--wagged her tail at me! I was stunned the first time it happened-and although it happens sporadically, every single time, I am so joyful and excited. It is amazing. Just amazing. Pasha has a chance to be wheelchair "free" if we keep going with rehab and the cold laser.
